MANDALA













Welcome to the India Tour of Mandala - a production by Sampradaya Dance Creations that is performed as a meditation in dance and music. Bridging the yantras of Hinduism and the sand mandalas of Tibetan Buddhist practice, the artists consecrate the stage and their bodies to a divine purpose of self-realization.

In the creation of this contemporary work - each movement, each gesture, each dancer is invested with the power of expressing the micro within the macro, the consecration of the space and the body to a divine purpose. Dance is in the moment, ephemeral and impermanent – as is the sand mandala.



It is said that at the centre of a Mandala, we will find our answers. We will know who we truly are.

From sanctifying the sacred space of the Tibetan sand mandala to the Shri Yantra embellished through the verses from Adi Shankaracharya's treasure trove of Soundarya Lahari, our dancers take you through a performance inspired by the intrinsic potential of the Sri Chakra.

We create and dismantle mandalas to signify the impermanence of all that we experience. We release their healing energies through flowing water and fire and to learn that all we have now is the infinite potential of the present moment.

This production is inspired by the Tibetan Sand Mandala and its philosophy of the impermanence of life through its illusory harmony and order. It is believed that the mandala is a cosmogram of the universe – a blueprint for three levels of existence and that they transmit positive energy to the environment and to those who participate and/or view them.

The creation of the sand mandala is a form of meditation requiring intense mental discipline and a state of self-surrender. While constructing a mandala, the Buddhist monks chant and meditate to invoke the divine energies of the deities residing within the mandala.

Using the dance forms of Bharatanatyam and Kathak rooted in the philosophical and aesthetic traditions of India, we find a remarkable congruency in the two traditions rooted in Hinduism and Buddhism. Dance is a form of meditation that has an inner higher purpose, one of transcending the mundane to self-realization. As well, our work is inspired by the construction of the mandala and its geometrical design, its layering of patterns, the subtle interplay of colored sand and the focused attention to detail. These are very necessary and integral elements in bharatanatyam – a dance form recognized for its geometric movement syntax expressed in complex rhythmic principles.

Founder, Choreographer, Artistic Director Emerita, Sampradaya Dance Creations



Dancer, Choreographer, Teacher & Cultural Consultant, Lata Pada is recognized as one of Canada's leading artists and arts advocates. An award-winning artist, she holds the distinction of being the first South Asian artist to receive the prestigious national honor of the Order of Canada in 2009.

In January 2011, she was awarded the Pravasi Bharatiya Samman by the President of India. In 2012, she was honored with the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal for her contribution to the community as a Canadian citizen. More recently, Lata was inducted into the 2013 Inaugural Mississauga Legend's Row as well as being awarded the 2021 Lifetime Achievement Award by the Mississauga Arts Council.

As the Founder of Sampradaya Dance Creations, Lata's choreographic vision is compelled by her desire to redefine Bharatanatyam in the 'here and now' as it navigates new and uncharted territory resulting in a stunning range of solos, ensemble works and multi-disciplinary productions.

Lata has trained under India's eminent gurus Sangeet Natak Akademi Awardee, Kalaimamani Kalyanasundaram and the late Padmabhushan Kalanidhi Narayanan. Originally from Bangalore, India, she has made Canada her home since 1964. She holds an MFA in Dance from York University and is an Adjunct Professor in their Graduate Program. She founded Sampradaya Dance Creations and Sampradaya Dance Academy in 1990 after an extensive international solo career. Today both organizations are recognized as premier dance organizations in Canada and globally.


Suma Nair

Artistic Director, Sampradaya Dance Creations






Atri Nundy started learning

choreographed by Brandy Leary (Anandam Dancetheatre) and presented her own work-in-progress of Sequence at Wind Down Dance curated by Allen and Karen Kaeja and Michael Caldwell. She, along with her co-choreographer Tanveer Alam, presented The Tagore Project in the Spring of 2022 at Sampradaya Dance Theatre.



Dheerendra was initiated into dance by Guru Ruchi Sharma & Guru Taposh Giri. Thereafter he continued under the tutelage of Guru Pandit Rajendra Gangani Ji, who is a known Kathak Maestro of Jaipur Gharana & is the torch bearer of his Gharana in its purest form.

He has been an integral part of the Aditi Mangaldas Dance Company – The Drishtikon Dance Foundation. He has recently given a Solo performance at one of the world's most prestigious festival, Darbar Festival, curated by Mr. Akram Khan at the Sadlers Wells, London, UK. Dheerendra is currently working as a Senior Kathak Faculty with the Bharatiya Kala Kendra, Mandi House, New Delhi.









study of Kathak, she was awarded a

She has also performed in a range of arts and culture festivals including Kathak Mahotsav in (Delhi, 2011), Surya Festival (Kerala, 2012), Konark Festival (Konark, 2013), Aroha Fest (Ottawa; 2019) and Angikam (Toronto, 2021).



Toronto-based Tanveer Alam started his Kathak training with Sudeshna Maulik and pursued further nuanced learning with the Late guru Sandhya Desai. Alam is a 2019 graduate of The School of Toronto Dance Theatre. Alam has performed in the works of Rina Singha, Lata Pada, Padmini Chettur, Brandy Leary, Harikishan S. Nair, Sashar Zarif, Lucy Rupert, and Peter Chin.

As an emerging choreographer, he has presented work at SummerWorks Festival, Battery Dance Festival +, MAI - Montréal, arts, interculturels, CanAsian Dance Festival: Grit Short Dances, and Tangente.
